The public is invited to join Ontario Mayor Bob Switzer and the Ontario City Council in the official ceremonial dedication of the Wayne C. King Skate Park, located on the corner of Southwest Fourth Avenue and Southwest Seventh Street at noon Wednesday. The dedication date coincides with the second anniversary of King's death.

The Ontario City Council supported the construction of a new community skate park for recreational in-line skating, skateboarding and BMX cycling, following a proposal and commitment by Ontario's youth and adult volunteers to help finance and construct the facility.

July 21, 1997, the city council approved a resolution committing to name the new skate park after King, who is a former Ontario city council member.

The decision to dedicate the skate park in memory of King was made to honor his many years of civic and volunteer community service and his active involvement with Ontario's youth in the development of the skate park, a city spokesperson said.
