Ontario Splash Park Rules:

- An adult MUST accompany children under 8 into the Splash Pad Play Area.
- Running, horseplay and profane language are NOT permitted. Individuals engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior will be asked to leave the splash pad play area.
- This splash pad uses treated, recirculated water. DO NOT DRINK THE WATER.
- Using water toys is permitted. Do NOT hurt others in any way with these toys.
- Infants and toddlers must wear a swim diaper.
- Food or drinks are not permitted within the Splash Pad play area indicated with a yellow line.
- Strollers, walkers and wheelchairs are permitted.
- NO alcohol, glass, wheeled vehicles, skateboards or roller blades in the Splash Pad play area.
- Proper attire must be worn at ALL times. Street shoes are prohibited. Water shoes are recommended.
- Please do not swing, climb or pull on any of our Splash Pad equipment.
- In case of thunderstorm, lightning or severe weather, vacate the Splash Pad immediately.
- NO pets allowed.
- The Splash Pad is a tobacco free zone.
- No bathing, soap, detergent or shampoo allowed.
- Do NOT use the splash pad if you feel ill.
- Do NOT cover the drain.
- In case of an emergency, call 911.
